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## Important information about needles compatible with your SurePal™ pen device

Sandoz are writing to inform you of a recent update regarding the needles provided with your SurePal<sup>TM</sup> pen device.

You may have noticed that you received BD Micro-Fine Ultra<sup>TM</sup> 4mm Needles instead of previously supplied BD Micro-Fine Ultra<sup>TM</sup> 5mm needles. This change has been implemented as part of Sandoz's initiative to make BD Micro-Fine Ultra<sup>TM</sup> 4mm Needles available as a standard ancillary item for patients prescribed **Omnitrope**® (Somatropin).

Please note that the SurePal<sup>TM</sup> instructions for use leaflet accompanying your SurePal<sup>TM</sup> pen device has not been updated to reflect the addition of 4mm needles. Please be reassured that the BD Micro-Fine Ultra<sup>TM</sup> 4mm needles have been assessed by Sandoz and have been confirmed to be compatible with the SurePal<sup>TM</sup> Pen.

Shorter needles can be associated with reduced discomfort during the injection process. However, we understand that using BD Micro-Fine Ultra<sup>TM</sup> 4mm Needles may feel different and if you prefer to switch back to BD Micro-Fine Ultra<sup>TM</sup> 5mm Needles, please inform your homecare company, and they will ensure that you receive 5mm needles with your next delivery.
